



The Developmental Screening Early Intervention Demonstration Project

The Children and Families Commission of Orange County is piloting a new project to benefit Orange County's young children by enhancing pediatric practices to address developmental concerns in children consistent with the AAP policy statement for surveillance, screening with standardized tests such as the Ages and Stages and PEDS and referral for evaluation and early childhood services

Incentives for Eligible Pediatricians and Family Practice Physicians Include:

- Screening tools available at no cost to you for one year, either paper or electronic
- Financial recognition for your time and participation: \$200 for attending the training, \$50 if staff member attends with physician, \$500 for implementation of project in your office, and \$250 at three and six months when data collection is submitted.
- Support in connecting children to valuable community resources / interventions
- Technical assistance for one year on topics including the use of screening tools, billing for developmental screening, and referral resources
- Acknowledgment from the Commission, Orange County Medical Association and the American Academy of Pediatrics for enhancing your practice in this way
- CMEs provided will be 6 hours

Eligibility Requirements for Project Participation and Incentives:

- Pediatricians and family practice physicians must treat children birth through five years
- Pediatricians and family practice physicians cannot be involved in other Commission funded programs
- Attendance at a one-time 6-hour training session about the importance of early screening and intervention; the use of standardized tools, including electronic web-based options; client engagement; patient follow up; and administrative support and billing
 - ◆ Nursing and office staff are welcome to attend with the physician as space is available
 - ◆ All physicians in a practice are encouraged to attend a training session
